Topic: Biodiversity Register (KAUSHAL BODH)

“Biodiversity is the foundation of life — protect it, preserve it, and pass it on.”

During the summer holidays, students will be focusing on preparing a Biodiversity Register as part of the CBSE Kaushal initiative. Through this activity, students will observe and document the plants, animals, birds, insects, and other living organisms found in their surroundings, thereby developing awareness towards environmental conservation and sustainable living.

***IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION: ***

1. All homework must be done on separate A3 sheets for each subject.
2. Use neat handwriting, proper headings, and colourful presentation.
3. Students may decorate the sheets with drawings, borders, pictures, and labels related to biodiversity and nature.

****SUBJECT - ENGLISH ****

1. Write a short poem of 2 to 3 stanzas (8–12 lines) celebrating the variety of life around you.

Tip: to use words that describe sounds (like buzzing, rustling, or chirping) and colours.

2. You recently went on a nature walk. Write a diary entry in about 100–120 words describing the biodiversity you observed and expressing your feelings about the importance of protecting it.
