## "Freedom is something you have to fight for. We have fought hard to earn it, so let's celebrate our freedom. Never let go of it and always carry it in your heart."

India has completed 75 years of independence; the Government of India celebrated this special national festival as the nectar festival of independence.

We encourage you to review the newsletter and learn about the activities, programme and communication tools used for children. 75th Anniversary of Indian Independence or Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav was an event, in which the 75th Anniversary of the Independence of India was celebrated in India and abroad. It was 76th Independence Day of India.

In the national flag of India **the top band is of Saffron colour, indicating the strength and courage of the country**. The white middle band indicates peace and truth with Dharma Chakra. The last band is green in colour shows the fertility, growth and auspiciousness of the land. Students made Tri-colour flag on 4 August 2022 and were filled with the spirit of patriotism.

Har Ghar Tiranga is a campaign under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India's independence.Our school organised rally from 6 August 2022 to 12 August 2022 for classes 4 to 12.

Raksha Bandhan is a **Hindu festival honouring the special bond shared between siblings**. It is celebrated enthusiastically in all parts of India. Students from junior wing celebrated the festival on 10 August 2022.

Our relationship with the flag has always been more formal and institutional than personal. Bringing the flag home collectively as a nation in the 75th year of independence thus becomes symbolic of not only an act of personal connection to the Tiranga but also an embodiment of our commitment to nation-building. The idea behind the initiative is to invoke the feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the people and to promote awareness about the Indian National Flag.To evoke the feeling of nationalism an essay writing competition was organised on 12 August 2022 for the students in English and Hindi category.

The students of our school with our other schools took out a tricolor rally on 13 August 2022 on the streets of Vaishali and chanting the slogan 'Har Ghar Tiranga'.

The **Independence Day of India**, which is celebrated religiously throughout the Country on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August every year, holds tremendous ground in the list of national days, since it reminds every Indian about the dawn of a new beginning, the beginning of an era of deliverance from the clutches of British colonialism of more than 200 years.
